7. Create - The Outcome

When creating **The Outcome** it is important get feedback from key **Stakeholders**. It is best to present your **Concepts**, and **Developed Solutions** to other people, and ask them to comment on the suitability of your design work.

* Listen closely to **Stakeholder** feedback, then use all of the information that you have gathered so far to adapt a final solution which solves problems outlined in **The Brief**.

The process of getting **Stakeholder** feedback is a key part of creating **The Outcome**. The final solution that you develop is most likely to be an improved adaption of solutions you have previously worked on.

HOW TO CREATE THE OUTCOME –

- Refer back to **The Brief**, reading over it to get a real understanding of what your design work is meant to be focused on.
 - Look closely at the **Concepts** and **Developed Solutions** that you have worked on.
 - Look over your **Research**, and think about how to complete the project so that it will be desired by the target market, and appropriate for the business that you are working with.
 - Keep referring back to the **The Brief**, to make sure that your solution is actually solving the problem that you set out to solve!!
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- Use all of the insight that you have gained to create and present a polished solution.

NOTE: Make your work is presentable; so that you could get up in front of a group and sell it to them if you were asked to. Your research, concepts, and other development work will be very helpful here.
